


Do the right thing - Rules for collection

These rules are in place for everyone's benefit and to keep our streets safe and tidy.

- 1. Your entire load or part of it may be rejected if you put out a large number of items that are unacceptable. Please remove anything the collection team rejects within 24 hours.**
- Sort your waste into **3 piles**. Each pile must be no more than 2 cubic metres - this equals the amount that would fit in a standard (6x4 foot) box trailer. Different types of waste may be collected at different times in the same week.
- Make sure individual items don't weigh more than 30 kg and can be handled by 2 people.
- Tie loose items in a bundle or put them in a sturdy box (no plastic bags).
- Don't obstruct footpaths, roads or driveways.
- Put your items out before **8 am on the Monday of your collection week**, but no earlier than **1 week before**.
- Do not empty your garbage bin onto these piles.

SORT INTO 3 PILES:



This equals the amount you would fit in a standard (6x4 foot) box trailer. Items must be able to be handled by a maximum of 2 people.

Please contact our office if you are a senior or disabled resident and you would like assistance to move your rubbish.

We can accept

Bulky waste: furniture and bookshelves, appliances, white goods with doors removed (excluding fridges), household goods/loose items, glass and mirrors (must be wrapped), mattresses, baby or child car seats, large plastic toys, swing sets, gym equipment, basketball goals, scrap metal, sawn timber off-cuts.

Green waste: garden cuttings/prunings and tree branches up to 75 mm in diameter and 1.5 m in length (tie in bundles up to 300 mm diameter), single tree limbs up to 200 mm in diameter (free of branches and/or leaves), tree roots that can be lifted by two people. **Grass clippings, leaves and prunings (< 10 cm in diameter) can go in your green-lid FOGO bin.**

Electronic waste: TV's, laptops, DVD players, printers

We can't accept

Tyres, chemicals, hazardous household waste (oil*, gas bottles*, pesticides, herbicides, house/pool chemicals), fire extinguishers*, poisons, asbestos, pesticide, paint* and batteries*.

*Take these items to the Community Recycling Centres at Coleambally and Jerilderie Waste Depots.

Your entire load may be rejected if you put out a large number of items that are unacceptable. Please remove anything the collection team rejects within 24 hours.

Please don't bag your items.

Did you know?

You can drop these items off for free all year round at the Community Recycling Centres (CRCs) at Jerilderie and Coleambally Waste Depots (landfills) (20 kg limit):

- Household quantities of paint and oil
- Gas bottles
- Car and household batteries
- Smoke detectors
- Fluoro globes
- Fire extinguishers

Council offices have mini stations that accept household batteries, smoke detectors, fluoro globes, laser toner cartridges and mobile phones. Coleambally and Jerilderie Men's Shed accept car batteries.
