The Coleambally Australia Day 2021 Committee in conjunction with Murrumbidgee Council invite community members to participate in this year's modified Australia Day celebrations on the grassed area at Coleambally Community Hall on Tuesday, 26th January, 2021.

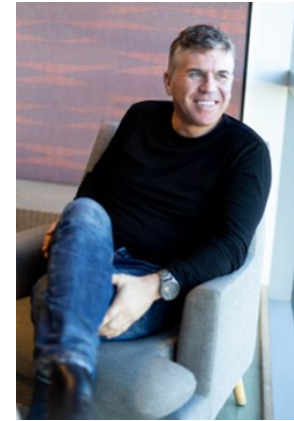
Covid-19 restrictions will apply.

- You must enter through the marked entry point.
- Attendees must sanitise their hands on arrival and go through the QR code entry. If you do not have this facility on your phone it will be done for you. You will then be provided with a wrist band.
- This wrist band entitles you to a free breakfast which will be served to you in a package. Free Breakfast will be bacon and egg rolls, fresh fruit salad and fruit juice or water. There will be no self-serve.

- Sanitising stations will be in the area for hand cleaning.
- Rubbish will be collected by COVID Marshalls or can be placed in nearby bins.
- You will be required to sit and stay seated on the spots which have been marked to observe social distancing. A number of chairs will be provided.
- At this time, we are allowed 100 people.
- Protect others and stay at home if you're unwell. If you're experiencing cold or flu-like symptoms get tested for COVID-19.
- There will be a marked exit point to which COVID Marshalls will direct you at the end of the program.
- Please bring a hat and sunscreen.
