Applications are invited for the 2022 Sir John Monash Education Bursary.

Referencing Sir John Monash's famous quote: "*Adopt as your fundamental creed that you equip yourself for life, not solely for your own benefit but for the benefit of the whole community*", applicants are invited to submit an essay which will explore and laterally apply Monash's philosophy to our need to arm and strategise on a global level, preparing for "the inevitable".

Speak clearly to the values and principles embraced by Monash, which made him a master tactician. Identify and elaborate on these attributes and articulate how they are sound and timeless and will lead and inform our action plan as we move forward in this brave new world.

Entry in this essay is open to residents of Murrumbidgee Council area who are considering entering into post secondary education through University, College or TAFE, or an approved course of formal training with a Registered Training Organisation, ie apprentices, trainees, adult education. Entries close at 4.00pm on Friday 28 October 2022.

The bursary is valued at \$2,000 and is awarded to assist with personal costs associated with course expenses. The successful applicant will be announced at the Remembrance Day Service to be held at the Jerilderie Cenotaph on Friday 11 November 2022, commencing 11.00am.
