ELIGIBILITY

Waste to Art is open to all community members and organisations, artists, schools and preschools. Entries will be accepted from Council areas other than Murrumbidgee Local Government Area, but only people/organisations within the Murrumbidgee Council area will be eligible for a prize.

- Artworks must demonstrate the reuse and recycling of waste.
- Competition results will be published on the Murrumbidgee Council website, social media, and through media outlets.
- Prize winners will be notified by Murrumbidgee Council.
- All entrants grant permission to publish and/or broadcast the names and photographs of the finalists and the winners and images of their artworks through print and electronic media.
- Judges and their immediate families are not eligible to enter.

ALL ARTWORKS MUST

- Be labelled with your name and contact details.
- Include an artist's statement (max 200 words) explaining your artwork (see entry form).
- Be stable and safe for public exhibition with no sharp protruding pieces.
- Not exceed a weight of 20 kgs or a size limit of 1 metre in any one direction.
- Be exhibition ready. If your artwork is to be hung, it must include a hanging system or be framed with D-rings and if it is free-standing it must stand independently and safely.
- If sending by courier, include instructions for display or installation in the package (couriered at own expense).

Artworks and copyright remain the property of the entrant. If your work is for sale, you agree to your details being made public to interested buyers.

*For the purpose of this competition a 'Professional Artist' is defined as an individual who may not necessarily have formal art education but has a history of exhibiting in solo or group exhibitions.

EXHIBITION DETAILS

All artworks must be delivered/couriered to one of the following Murrumbidgee Council offices by 12 noon on Friday 16 June:

- 21 Carrington Street, Darlington Point NSW 2706
- 35 Jerilderie Street, Jerilderie NSW 2716

At the completion of the exhibition, entries can be collected from any of the above locations (please indicate on entry form). If using a courier, their fees are the responsibility of the entrant).

The organisers will take all reasonable care in handling and dealing with works submitted, however, will not be held responsible for any loss or damage incurred to any of the artworks or materials. There is no insurance on exhibits. An artist requiring insurance will need to take out their own insurance.
