Our Council footprint continues to be a desirable location for renewable energy development, both solar and wind turbine - during the month Council has held conversations and meetings with interested developers -it is a highly competitive market and interested parties are looking to mobilise quickly.

Health continues to be an area in which Council finds itself actively engaged. Positive news is that the Coleambally community is once again being delivered a Child and Maternal Health Service. This is a start point and one we hope to build on in the community services area.

MLHD/Council update occurred via a Teams Meeting - an update on the critical staff issues, the current and continuing COVID Strategy and the flu immunisation program.

The RAMJO Health Sub Committee met in Jerilderie and prioritised it's focus for advocacy for the coming months, including Ambulance accessibility, recruitment and retention of staff, including overseas trained medical staff across all fields.

I had the pleasure of conducting a Citizenship Ceremony in Jerilderie on 16 June.

Our Council and our nation warmly welcomed Charme and Johan Van der Walt, Michaela Walsh and Jane McMillan. This important step for them personally adds to the character and diversity of our great country, and we congratulate them for taking this step.

The General Manager and I attended the National General Assembly in Canberra from the 19-22 June 2022. During the 3.5 days, we attended a Regional Forum, an address by the Governor General, keynote addresses by Stan Grant on global democracy, Alicia McKay on thinking differently about Local Government, Marcus Spiller on Local Government and productivity, panel discussion on population housing and workforce, an address by Linda Burney, Minister for Indigenous Australians - Closing the Gap and a confronting but heartfelt address by the very new Ukraine Ambassador to Australia.

We have a new ARIC Chair, Linda MacRae and Panel Member Steven Pinnuck who met with Council staff and Council delegate Cr Black yesterday. Council welcomes our new Committee members.

It would appear we are getting very close to the completion of a couple of major projects in Coleambally - a pleasing place to find ourselves at.
