The SDLAM Project Team public consultation was rolled out over three days 23-24-25 February 2021 - from commencement in Moulamein to Wanganella, Conargo, Jerilderie and finally Morundah, all sessions were well attended and raised many important questions and allowed the communities to impart valuable historical information. The Project Team were given a first hand glance at the palpable level of anxiety and uncertainty - the meetings spoke very clearly to the modernisation projects - 1 challenge at a time.

On 2 March 2021, General Manager John Scarce and I attended a Ministerial Road Show convened by RAMJO and led by Federal Minister for Resources, Water and Northern Australia, Hon Keith Pitt, MP, Hon Sussan Ley, MP, Minister for the Environment, Senator Perin Davey, Senator Bridget McKenzie and many representatives from the Commonwealth Environmental Water Holder (CEWH) at Picnic Point. It was important that Minister Pitt actually visited this part of the Murray Darling Basin, and viewed first hand the all consuming issues greatly impacting us in an ongoing manner.
