Value of Scholarship:

Scholarship Fund of \$3,000 to be distributed among three (3) successful applicants. One applicant from each of the towns within the Council area (Coleambally, Darlington Point and Jerilderie).

Tenure:

One Year

Eligibility:

Applicants must:-

- Have an address in the Murrumbidgee Council area as the principal place of residence
- Possess a sound academic record
- Demonstrate personal accomplishments and qualities
- Be able to demonstrate a significant contribution to school and community activities
- Demonstrate the capacity to be a good ambassador for the Murrumbidgee Council area

Selection:

Applicants must complete the Murrumbidgee Council Scholarship Application Form, attaching copies of relevant documents. Candidates short-listed for scholarships may be interviewed.

Preference may be given to applicants expressing a desire to return to the Council area at the completion of studies.
