AMBASSADOR WARREN POTENT

Warren has been ranked the Number 1 Prone Rifle Shooter in the world six times in his career. He has represented Australia at the Sydney, Athens, Beijing, London and Rio de Janeiro Olympic games. Warren is Australia's most successful rifle shooter ever.



His achievements include:-

- Holder of 2 Commonwealth records.
- 1st Australian rifle shooter to win a World Cup Final.
- Only Australian rifle shooter to win an Olympic medal.
- Only Australian rifle shooter to compete at 5 Olympics.
- Only Australian rifle shooter to win a World championship.
- One of only 2 people in the world to be both the Commonwealth and World Champion at the same time.
- 5 x Olympian, Olympic medalist.
- 30 years competing in international competition.
- 4 x Commonwealth medals including 1 individual Gold.
- 12 x World Cup medals including 7 Gold.
- 3 x World Cup Final medals including 1 Gold.
- 3 x World Championship medals including 2 Gold.

Warren has competed for over 30 years in World Championships, World Cups, Commonwealth Games, Commonwealth Championships, Oceania Championships, Olympic Games, State Titles and has been named Australian Shooter of the year three years in a row. Some of the highlights of his career were in 2008 when Warren won a bronze medal at the Beijing Olympic Games. The first ever Olympic medal for an Australian rifle shooter and in 2014 Warren had possibly his best year ever, reaching every international final that he competed in. He also won the Commonwealth Games gold medal, then a month later, won the World Championships, his first individual world title as well as becoming the first Australian rifle shooter to do so.

Warren's other interests include: Amateur watchmaking, old style engines, fishing (when he has any time) and music.
